Attached is the revised version. We've included clean and compare versions. Changes are summarized below, as well.

Changes since the June 4 file address the following:

DOJ comments

- Include an Executive Summary
- In the section summarizing history of O3 criteria and standards, shorten/distill text wrt older court decisions and augment the text on 2019 one
- Add text soliciting comment on aspects of the Administrator's rationale, judgements, etc.; insure describe any Admin conclusions/etc as proposed
- Shorten the sections at beginning of Sections II (Primary) and III (Secondary) that provide background on the current standard and make more clear that these summaries are provided as background in the introductory text and that the current Administrator's conclusions are in later sections (II.D.3 and III.D.3).
- Include any more detail provided by CASAC in their advice with regard to adequacy of the standard (e.g., on primary split).
- Be sure to define and explain what PA and ISA are.

OMB comments provided in two track changes files

- Revisions in paragraph describing changes in causality determinations for mortality and cardiovascular effects.
- Revisions in paragraph describing limitations of information on climate effects with regard to ability to develop quantitative assessments.
- Drop "cert. denied"s
- Avoid brackets in legal cites
- In recognizing uses of lands beneficial to the public welfare (in FN that quoted from parks and wilderness areas' statutes), also recognize national forests managed for multiple uses (and relevant statute on that)
- Few other phrasing areas (e.g., on forested areas)
- Miscellaneous editorial (e.g., commas, left out words)

Cleanup by EPA

- Information on public hearings known at this point (hearings likely to be similar in format to PM)
- Revised template regarding docket office
- Other miscellaneous cleanup, such as reference corrections
