SUBJECT: Authorization to extend the public comment period for the Propylene Oxide Proposed Interim Registration Review Decision by 30 days

This memorandum authorizes a 30-day extension of the comment period on the proposed interim registration review decision for propylene oxide, which is currently available for public comment in the registration review docket for this case. The documents are accessible at <https://www.regulations.gov>; the docket ID number is EPA-HQ-OPP-2013-0156.

On October 23, 2020, a Federal Register Notice was published announcing the availability and opening of a 60-day public comment period on the proposed interim registration review decision and supporting documents for propylene oxide, as part of the registration review process required under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act. The deadline for submitting comments on these documents was announced as December 22, 2020, which was 60 days from the date that the Federal Register Notice published. On November 13, 2020, EPA received a request from ABERCO, Inc., the sole registrant of propylene oxide products, to extend the comment period for an additional 60 days. The requestor stated that the extension was necessary because both the proposed interim decision and draft risk assessment for these registration review cases were released at the same time. As a result, the requestor needed more time to prepare public comments in response to these documents. In addition, the extension would allow time to request, receive, and review the PERFUM model runs that informed the Agency's proposed buffer zone requirements.

After consideration of the request, EPA is extending the comment period for the Propylene Oxide Proposed Interim Registration Review Decision by 30 days. The original closing date was

December 22, 2020. The new closing date for the propylene oxide public comment period is January 21, 2021. The propylene oxide case and docket numbers and contact information are listed below.
