



Public Notice: Request For Comments

EPA proposes to issue a draft Air Quality Permit to Operate for Great Lakes Gas Transmission - Deer River, MN on the Leech Lake Band of Ojibwe Indian Reservation

The purpose of this notice is to invite you to submit written comments on this proposed permit through the processes described in this notice.

When are written comments due?

The comment period closes on October 2nd, 2020.

What is being proposed?

The EPA proposes to issue renewed federal Clean Air Act Title V Permit to Operate in accordance with 40 Code of Federal Regulations, Part 71, for:

Great Lakes Gas Transmission Limited Partnership
Deer River Compressor Station No. 4
Leech Lake Band of Ojibwe Indian Reservation
31641 Great Lakes Road
Deer River, Minnesota 56636

The facility is a natural gas compression station that emits regulated air pollutants. This permitting action allows the facility to continue operating for another five (5) years but does not authorize an increase in emissions.

Because the facility is located within the exterior boundaries of the Leech Lake Band of Ojibwe Indian Reservation and because the Leech Lake Band of Ojibwe does not have an EPA-approved permitting program, it is the EPA's responsibility to issue the Operating Permit.

How can I review documents?

You can review the draft Operating Permit, the Statement of Basis, the application and other supporting materials, including all data submitted by the applicant, at the following locations:

Will there be a public hearing?

No public hearing has been scheduled; however, you may request a public hearing. A request for a hearing must be submitted within fifteen (15) days of this notice and must include the nature of the issues to be raised at the hearing. EPA will base its decision on whether a hearing will be held upon the showing of a significant degree of public interest.

What happens next?

The EPA will review and consider all comments received during the comment period. Following this review, the EPA may issue the permit, issue the permit with revisions or deny the permit.
