I forgot to ask about whether CARB intends to request EPA to “limit its approval of the budgets submitted to last until the effective date of future U.S. EPA adequacy findings for replacement budgets.” (Quote from CARB’s October 25, 2017 letter submitting the Eastern Kern 2017 ozone plan.) My understanding from Karina (via Mani) is that CARB does not intend to request that EPA limit the duration of the new 2020 budgets. Can you confirm?
